2. CONDITIONS OF ACCESS AND TERMS OF ADMISSION

Conditions of access

- License (BAC +3) in Computer Science or in a related field
- Level of French at least DELF B2 (according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages) or equivalent (TCF 400), except for candidates from the countries where French is spoken as the main or official language, and for those with a university degree in the French language

Terms of admission

- Steps:
 - ✓ Application review
 - ✓ Interview (by Skype or by phone)
- Criteria: Level of study including university years, language level, a letter of recommendation, a student motivation letter, etc.

3. TUITION FEES & SCHOLARSHIPS

Tuition fees (reduced)

Tuition fees are 85 million VND (~ 3,700 USD) for 2 years. These costs amount to only 50% of the total cost of the training (170 million dong) thanks to the support of the VNU and IFI partners.

Scholarships

- **La Francophonie scholarships:** foreign students will benefit from a housing allowance (in UNVH university residences, excluding charges), and a monthly allowance for a 16-month period.
- **Business grants:** awarded to the most outstanding students in class with the support of IFI partner companies. These grants cannot be combined with those of La Francophonie (depending on the agreement between IFI and partner companies each academic year).

4. REGISTRATION FORM

Applications

2. CV and cover letter (in French)
3. Photocopy certified to the originals of the university diploma (s) (in French and English)
4. Photocopy certified to the originals of the transcripts of academic years (in French and English)
5. Letter of recommendation from a professor or a computer expert (in English)
6. Health certificate issued by the competent health services of the candidate 's country of residence, less than six months before sending the file **(with a certified translation in English)**. This document must ensure absence of any infectious or congenital diseases
7. Copy of a valid passport for at least 30 months
8. Four 3x4 cm photos (taken within six months before application)
9. Proof of sufficient financial resources to cover the costs of staying in Vietnam, for example with one of the following documents provided **in English**:
 - Bank account statement in the name of the candidate, certified by the bank and indicating a minimum balance of 3600 USD or its equivalent
 - Letter from an individual or an organization financing the candidate 's studies, with the copies of his/her identity card and the bank account statement indicating a minimum balance of 3600 USD or its equivalent
 - Proof of obtaining a Vietnamese bank account in the name of the candidate, if the account has already been credited with a minimum balance of 3600 USD or its equivalent
 - Proof of a student / study loan issued by a bank
 - All other legal and commonly accepted proofs

All amounts indicated in the proofs must be in USD.

Please note: original scanned documents 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 8 may be submitted in advance in French. The other documents (6, 9) and certified English translations can be submitted after the validation of the preliminary files.

Deposit application

Step 1: The digital registration file must be submitted to one of the following emails: etudes@ifi.edu.vn / etudes.ifi@gmail.com before the specified deadlines.

Step 3: Successful applicants must provide original paper documents upon their arrival in Vietnam

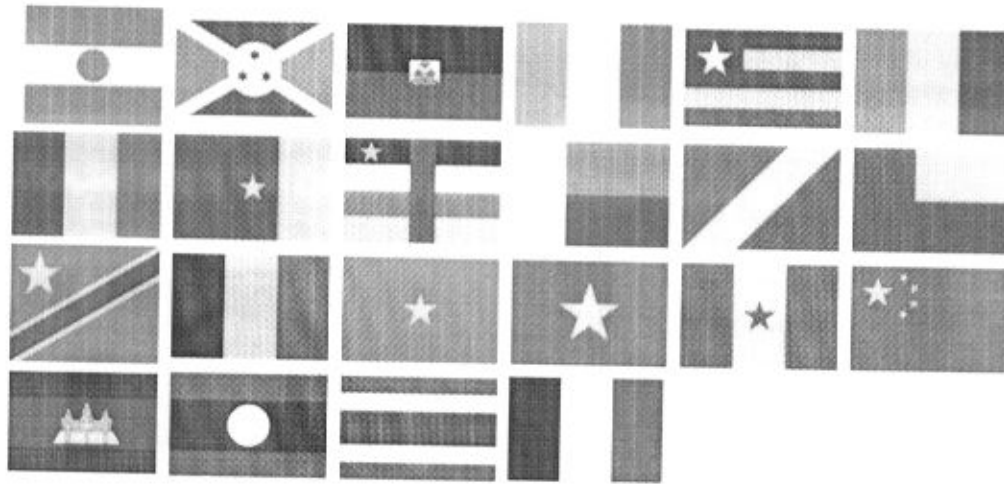
