The next historical figure of the "Famous Teachers of Garabagh" project of the Ministry of Education is Yusif Valazir Chamanzaminli. He was born in 1887 in the town of Shushar "Imagine a town at the top of a mountain with greenery in spring and summer, covered by fog in autumn and by snow in winter. This is my city ... Every point of the city tells a story ... "said Yusif Vazir Chamanzaminli, the writer-publicist, enlightened intellectual, statesman and sociopolitical figure, the first ambassador of the Azerbaijan People's Democratic Republic to Eurkey. For Yusif Vazir Chamanzaminli, the town of Shusha was the foundation of his glorious life.

The teaching also played a key role in a rich activity of Yusif Vazir Chamanzaminli. He taught Azerbaijani and Russiandanguages at the faculties of Oriental Studies and Redagogy of the Azerbaijan State University and date at the Redagogical, Medical and Retroleum Institutes. In 1938, the began working as a senior teacher of Russian language at the Kharezm Province Redagogical institute in Uzbekistan, and was also appointed director of the institute's library. Noting the crucial role of education and upbringing in the national development, Yusif Vazir wrote that a nation without schools is like a tree without roots; it lacks the strength it needs to survive, and it dries up and dies.

"Our goal is Azerbaijan," said Yusif Vezir Chamanzaminli and he was always serving to this goal. Yusif Vezir Chamanzaminli is remembered as a true patriotic intellectual by his people.
