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Education Minister, Misir Mardanov, talked about the school chain history, and noted that at the beginning of the last century, there were a small number of secondary schools in Azerbaijan, however, from the 1920s-1930s the number of schools had considerably increased. First, this process has accelerated in the general compulsory primary education, afterwards, with the view of provide each individual with general compulsory education even in small settlements had been opened schools, the Minister said.

Misir Mardanov noted instead of brining school to a learner would be correctly to bring him to school. Having underlined existing of this experience in the world, he stressed that in small settlements of several countries, as well as in big cities pupils are taking to schools by bus.

Education Minister brought to the attention of participants the schedule of statistical data for placement secondary schools with a small number of pupils in districts, the number of schools operating in in one settlement and teachers, who are working in several schools. Afterwards, the minister has acquainted participants with proposals of rationalization of the school chain in Ujar district, which have been prepared.

Tasks for the school chain rationalization in the country have been given to the relevant departments of Ministry, as well as district and city's education departments.
