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M Misir Mardanov welcomed the guests at the Ministry of Education and expressed satisfaction from seeing them. Having noted the importance of fruitful collaboration existing between the UNICEF Baku Office and Ministry of Education, the Minister underlined the significance of projects implementing in the education field.
