The awarding ceremony of winners of “No one is forgotten. Nothing is forgotten” project and the international children’s drawing competition of “Saved world remembers too...”, devoted to the 65th anniversary of Great Patriotic War conducted by the initiative of Embassy of the Russian Federation was held at the Russian Information Cultural Centre in Baku.

Pupils from more than 40 schools, lyceums, gymnasiums of Baku and pilot schools chosen on the intensive Russian language study of the different regions took part in the best poem, song and picture competitions held within the mentioned project from February to June of the current year.
