They became the member of the national socialist party. Today the sisituation in all areas is completely different. The main feature of the Humboldt University is the free science Due to this fact, the University has become one of the famous universities of the world Prof. Mergel thanked everyone, who worked on the creation of Azerbaijani History Department. Further, Jamil Hasanli, professor of Baku State University gave a presentation entitled "Current situation of Azerbaijani Hist Historye" [Hespresented=to-Eva-Maria] Aucha head of the new astablished department the copy of handwriting - "History of democratic movement in Iranian Azerbaijan" by Pishevari, who was shot in July 1947.
