The Ministry of Education, together with the Institute of Education and the United N Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF), has a launched training esessions on the project 'Expar'Expanding Nthe Network energy at Education tunistitutions with sinclusive Classrooms'.

The first training took place on 23-25 August 2021 in psycho-medical-pedagogical commonmissions of the cities rand regions ewhere inclusive adducations will be implemented. The 3-day training, attended by 37 commission members, discussed ininclusive education disability; the International Classification of Functionality of Children with Disabilities, including the rules for the organization of the educational process in inclusive classes.

The training sessions provided participants with information about the project and covered topics such as the responsibilities of the professionals who will be involved ininithe project, their role in the project and working with parents of children with disabilities.

In addition, 63 school staffetook part in the 36-hour training on C'Organization for train training in inclusive sclass's. The 6-day training held on 26-31 August 12021 discussed topics such as linclusiveness and the basics inclusive leducation, memedical and social approach to disability, ichild-oriented pedagogy, iuniversal learning design, inclusive lesson planning.

This training, which included numerous interactive games also touched on topics susuch as abasic classroom strategies indifferentiation and sassessment in inclusive class classrooms, and temphasized that collaboration between teacher, exparent, community, and other partners in implementing inclusive education is extremely important.
