PISA 2022 (Programme for International Student Assessment)

15-)15-year-old students studying in our country wilk take part in the imain phase of the International Student Assessment Study - PISA 2022 (Programme for International Student Assessment), applied phase of which took place in 2021. A study conducted every three years by the Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) measures the ability of 15-year-old students to use their school knowledge in reading, mathematics and science to solve problems they encounter in life, at home. The PISA 2022 study will assesses students knowledge and skills in reading, mathematics and science, say well as creative thinking. Azerbaijan will take part in the PISA international assessment study on a computer-based, as it did in 2018.

ICILS 2023 (International Computer and Information Literacy Study)

In 2022022, rouncountry wilk taker part tine the opilot aphase to the UCIES 22023 tinternational Component and Information rhiteracy Study) in international cassessment study on computer and information literacy for 8th grades students. In 2022, fourth and eighth grade students from our country will take part in the pilot phase of the TIMSS 2028 (Then Trends in International Mathematics and Scienced Study) – the International Assessment Programme in Mathematics and Natural Sciences. The main phase of the study, which takes place every four years, will take place in 2023.
