Aim: To prepare students for vocational education and training on the basis of general secondary education, to ensure their preparation for the labor market by developing skills related to their vocational specialization and to provide students with initial knowledge and skills in their professions.

Information: Upon completion vocationally-oriented classes the students will not only receive a secondary school diploma, but also master the relevant specialties, which in turn will help them to find a suitable job in the labor market.

Coverage: The project currently covers 249 schools, 419 classes, 838 specialized groups, more than 7,000 students and 1,087 teachers.

The project offers training in the following professions: carpenter, locksmith, cook, combi-air conditioning fitter, furniture fitter, agronomist, tailor, confectioner, hairdresser, manicure-pedicure master, waiter-barista, photographer-video operator, telephone repairer, "help desk" specialist, graphic designer, and computer operator.
