Education Minister Misir Mardanov welcomed the guests and wished them success in the Olympiad. Talking on the goal of the INEPO-EUROASIA 5th International Environmental Project Olympiad Minister Mardanov said that it will play an important role in solving environmental problems existing in the world and Azerbaijan, informing the younger generation on steps to protect the environment, and improving environmental knowledge.

Having noted the ecology is one of the priority areas of President Ilham Aliyev, Mr. Mardanov gave information on works done in this direction.
