First graduation ceremony of a dual degree master program in "Educational Policy and Administration" between Azerbaijan State Pedagogical University (ASPU) and George Washington University (GWU) of the USA was held on June 13.

At the end of the ceremony, the graduates were presented with honorary diplomas.

agreement signed between ASPU and GWU as part of the "State Program on Enhancing International Competitiveness of the Higher Education System in the Republic of Azerbaijan for 2019-2023", which was approved by the relevant decree of the President of Azerbaijan.
The dual degree program, funded by the State Oil Fund, is being implemented at ASPU to train world-class master administrators in education.
