On 24 June, the Minister of Education Emin Amrullayev took part in the 5th meeting of the Scientific Council of the International Turkic Academy in Nur-Sultan, the capital of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

Speaking at the meeting, the Minister of Education noted the importance of cooperation between the Turkish states in the field of education, including the importance of preparing joint textbooks. Emin Amrullayev spoke about Ahmad Baitursynov's contribution to the educational, scientific, cultural creativity of the Kazakh people and the peoples of the Turkic world, noting that studying the life and activities of the thinkers of the Turkic world and promoting their heritage in the world would further strengthen spiritual and cultural relations between Turkic-speaking states.
