The meeting was attended by Pro-rector of Hacettepe University Sevil Gurgan, dean of Economics Faculty Ahmed Burcen, Educational Attaché of the Embassy of Azerbaijan to Turkey Nasiba Nasibova, Rector of Azerbaijan Medical University Ahliman Amiraslanov and Rector of Azerbaijan State Economic University Shamsaddin Hajiyeu.
