A delegation from one of Kazakhstan's leading educational institutions, "Nazarbayev Intellectual Schools", is visiting the Republic of Azerbaijan.

As part of the visit, the Minister of Science and Education, Emin Amrullayev, has met with the delegation. During the meeting, views were exchanged on establishing direct links between "Nazarbayev Intellectual Schools" and general educational institutions in Azerbaijan, and proposals were made in this regard.

The delegation also visited the Baku school-lyceum No.20, physics, mathematics, and informatics biased lyceum, the Byulbyul Specialized Secondary School of Music, and the Baku European Lyceum.
