It should be noted that the figure in contrast to last year was 98800 people.

In 2010 the number of pupils graduated from XI classes of part-time and evening general education schools was 473 pupils. It is expected that this year the number of graduates will rise nearly to 710 people.

About 25.800 students of 342 secondary schools of Baku city (including 330 state and 12 non-state schools) will complete XI and 35.300 students IX classes.

The number of I class pupils studied at secondary schools in 2010/2011 study year was 120 420 people. In 2009/2010 academic year the figure was 118.947 pupils. 2124274 pupils is planned to be admitted to the first classes of general education schools in 2011/2012 study year.

Currently, 98 113 students are studying (90 360 at Bachelor's and 7 753 Master's level) at universities subordinated to the Ministry of Education.

24 088 students are studying (including 20 683 students at Bachelor's and 3 405 at Master's level,) at the last courses of universities subordinated to the Ministry of Education.

Moreover, 19 553 students are studying at private universities, including 18 980 students at Bachelor's and 773 Master's level.
