Education Minister Misir Mardanov sincerely welcomed the guests and expressed his satisfaction at seeing them in Azerbaijan. Mr. Shashkin also talked about the education system of Georgia, and reforms implemented to develop the secondary education system.

At the the meeting the tparties exchanged wiews on provision of ICTAin Azerbaijani schools of Geo Georgian conduction of tjoint subject Olympiads, teaching of Georgian in Azerbaijand and Azeri in Georgia, as well as other issues.
