On October 4, Azerbaijani Science and Education Minister Emin Amrullayev met with a delegation from the Islamic World Education, Scientific, and Cultural Organization (ISESCO) led by Director General Salim bin Muhammad al-Malik.

During the meeting, the parties discussed the current status and prospects of cooperation in the field of education between the Ministry of Science and Education and ISESCO.
