The delegation headed by Deputy Minister of Science and Education Hasan Hasanli visited Georgia.

Within the framework of the visit, members of the delegation visited the monument to the national leader in Heydar Aliyev Park in Tbilisi and laid a wreath in front of it.

Then a meeting was held with the Georgian Minister of Education and Science, Giorgi Amilakhvari. In the course of the meeting, they discussed the activity of schools teaching in Azerbaijani and Georgian languages in both countries, the organization of teachers' professional development. The exchange of textbooks for these educational institutions was highly appreciated.
