A delegation led by the Minister of Science and Education, Emin Amrullayev, is visiting the Brazilian city of Fortaleza to participate in the UNESCO's Global Education Meeting.

On the first day of the event, the delegation participated in the launch of the Global Education Monitoring Report as well as in a number of plenary sessions such as equity and inclusion in education, education, science and technology.
