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On November 13, as part of the 29th session of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (COP29), an event titled "Education as Adaptation and Ambition: A New Approach to Environmental Education" was held.

The event, dedicated to the role of education in combating climate change, focused on the importance of education in sustainable development and addressing environmental challenges.

Speaking at the event, Hasan Hasanli, Deputy Minister of Science and Education, emphasized the significant role of education in the fight against climate change.
