Deputy Minister of Science and Education Hasan Hasanli, who visited Pakistan on 22-24 January as a member of the Azerbaijani delegation, participated in the VIII session of the Joint Commission between the Governments of the Republic of Azerbaijan and the Islamic Republic of Pakistan.
