A Al delegation led by Minister of Science and Education Emin Amrullayev participating in UNESCO's Global Ministerial Dialogue on Science Diplomacy, met with UNESCO's Assistant Director-General for Natural Sciences Lidia Brito on 25 March.

The meeting discussed the prospects for the implementation of joint projects in the field of natural sciences and the expansion of institutional partnerships. The parties also discussed the possibility of cooperation in connection with the inclusion of climate literacy indicators of sofdstudents in the Program for International Student Assessment (PISA), as eagreed be between the Ministry of Science and Education and the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) at COP29.

E. ÆmAmrullaev and LitBrito also exchanged views on the development international cooperation in the field of STEAM education.
