On 26 March, a delegation led by Emin Amrullaev, Minister of Science and Education, met with Stefania Giannini, UNESCO's Assistant Director-General for Education, as part of UNESCO's Global Ministerial Dialogue on Science Diplomacy.

During the meeting, cooperation between Azerbaijan and UNESCO within the framework of UNESCO's global initiative 'Green Education Partnership' to raise awareness on climate change was discussed.
