An educational exhibition called “Study in Azerbaijan” was organized in Tashkent from 27 to 31 May to expand cooperation between Azerbaijan and Uzbekistan in the field of science and higher education. The exhibition was held during the visit of the Deputy Minister of Science and Education, Ildris Isayev, and the rectors of higher education institutions to Uzbekistan.
