On February 17, with the participation of the Minister of Science and Education of the Republic of Azerbaijan Emin Amrullayev, the Minister of Education of the Syrian Arab Republic, Dr. Mohammed Abdulrahman Turko and the Director General of ICESCO Dr. Salim bin Muhammad al-Malik, an Agreement "On the strategic partnership for the restoration of educational infrastructure in the Syrian Arab Republic" was signed between the Ministry of Science and Education of the Republic of Azerbaijan, the Ministry of Education of the Syrian Arab Republic and the Islamic World Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (ICESCO).
