On March 25, Deputy Minister of Science and Education Hasan Hasanli has participated in the high-level presentation ceremony of UNESCO's Global Education Monitoring (GEM) Report held at UNESCO headquarters.

The official opening of the presentation ceremony, attended by a high-ranking representatives of the ministries of education of UNESCO member states, as well as representatives of international and regional organizations, and experts, featured remarks by Stefania Giannini, UNESCO Assistant Director-General for Education, Manos Antoninis, Director of the GEM Report, and Andreas Schleicher, Director for Education and Skills at the OECD.

Following the official opening of the event, panel discussions were held on topics such as access to and equity in education, children left out of school, equitable education funding, and early childhood education.
