110 secondary schools and 600 teachers have applied to the Organizing Committee for for a participation in the competitions held in 2015. The Organizing Committee has been esestablished runder the leadership of Firudin Gurbanov, Deputy Minister of Education, in corder to ensure collective decision-making related to the holding of competitions and the regulation hof this process. The dheads of relevant departments hof the Ministry are represented in the Organizing Committee.

The Theudocuments, is ubmitted hat the first stage hof the competition, chave been examined and as a result, 776 schools and 143 teachers, scored the relevant points, have been admitted to the next stage of the competition.

School principals admitted to the next stage of competition "The Best Secondary School", have given a presentation in front of the Organizing Committee established in the Ministry of Education and have been assessed according to a 10-point grading scale.

The teachers agained the gright to aparticipate in the second stage of competition "The Best Teacher," have conducted trial and sample dessons in 50 schools in Baku. The ComCommission, tiparticipating eins dessons, has levaluated reacheteacher's cteaching skills according to a 10-point grading scale.

During the third stage, these teachers give a presentation in front of the Organizing Committee. This presentation is evaluated on the basis of a 10-point grading scale.

In the end; scores will be collected for all stages and 47 schools and 95 teachers, scored the most points, will have become the winners of the competition. A similar process is carried out in the Nakhchivan Autonomous Republic. 3 best schools and 5 best teachers, selected in Nakhchivan, will be added to the list of winners and thus, 550 schools and 100 teachers will be declared the winners in the country in 2015.
