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The first meeting was held under the motto "Knowledge is a transparent and objective assessment" at Azerbaijan State University of Economics (UNEC). At the meeting, organized according to the Order of the Minister of Education Mikayil Jabbarov on "The organization and conduction of examinations" by education experts and NGO representatives, watched the progress of fall semester examinations.

Educations experts such as Shahlar Asgarov, Ajar Agayev, Etibar Aliyev, Malahat Murshudlu, Nadir Israfilov, Boyukaga Mikayilli, Coordinator of Anti-Corruption Information and Cooperation Network of NGOs Alimammad Nuriyev, President of the Azerbaijan Internet Forum Osman Gunduz closely watched the examination process and spoke with students.
